On the day - The purpose of the clay shoot is to offer a fun, team competition and provide some practice for the genuine sporting shot. Teams of 5 people will shoot at 5 stands and a total of 50 clays from 10.00am. Everyone is welcome to join us for a BBQ and drink.

Scoring – top 4 scores will count. A team may shoot the layout more than once, re-entry is payable on the day, however the first score counts towards the team competition.

Prizes - Rosettes 1st to 6th

Special Prizes for: men's, ladies, junior and game keepers (must be employed within the hunt country) high score.

Entry Fees -

£150 per team.

Re-entry on the day £15 per person, time permitting and payable to the secretary after your first round has been shot.

Times – Approximate start times and stands will be issued and emailed on Friday 14th

Guns –The same gun must be used throughout except in the case of mechanical breakdown.

Cartridges – Felt wads only. Cartridges will be on sale for those with a shotgun certificate.

Certificates must be shown to the secretary when declaring your team. Scorers will have the authority to disqualify those not using felt wad cartridges.

5. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving a reason, to cancel or alter the classes and times.
6. The competition will be run under the CPSA English Sporting Rules. Safety rules of the CPSA will be strictly enforced.
7. Spectators must observe the safety precautions and dogs must be kept on short leads at all times.
